# *It is Time to Prepare for MDS 3.0*

**February 18, 2010, 1-2 p.m. ET**

Even though the transition to the MDS 3.0 is October 1 with training scheduled to begin in April, CMS is also encouraging the interdisciplinary team and staff to start preparing now, with the recommendation that the MDS 3.0 be viewed as a "new system or process," not as a revision of MDS 2.0.

Understanding and mastering the changes in how to interview, observe and assess residents will be instrumental to a facility's success in implementing the *resident's voice* in coding and care planning. This event will summarize the background and rationale in the changes and development of the 3.0 and provide direction for members of the interdisciplinary and management team to begin preparing for implementation.
